

A declaration of joint working between

Amicus Therapeutics UK and Royal Free London NHS Foundation Trust

Royal Free London NHS Foundation Trust and Amicus Therapeutics are engaged in a joint working project called:

Service improvement: Implementation of a Fabry App to empower Fabry patients to self-monitor signs and symptoms of their disease

This project will run for 12 months from February 2020, and both parties have contributed resources for this initiative.

Expected outcome:

Patients with Fabry Disease are better supported with implementation of a Fabry App, leading to better patient outcomes.

Key Deliverables

- Increase in Fabry App patient downloads & regular user interactions
- Patient reported outcomes better managed via threshold monitoring & reporting
- Development of resource to educate Royal Free LSDU staff & engage Fabry patients on benefits of the App
- Evaluation of the project that will better inform future modifications to the App

Financial arrangements

The project will be supported by a pooling of skills and resources from both Amicus and Royal Free London NHSFT, with a direct financial contribution provided by Amicus of £23102
